#### JOB PURPOSE:

To provide positive experiences and outcomes for children and young people, some of whom may be accommodated. Working with children, young people and their families to support them to achieve their identified care and support needs.

This includes managing two Residential provisions for children and young people looked after and in crisis, through the effective management of resources in accordance with statutory regulations and the Council's policies and procedures.

Work with the Deputy Manager and Behaviour Analyst to ensure each child / young person has a care and support plan and a behaviour management plan so that any challenging behaviour is consistently managed.

Support young people in their transition towards independence and life post 18.

Provide additional management cover across all of BCBC's children's residential homes when this service is dormant, where other Managers are not available due to annual leave/sickness absence/training.

#### PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACTIVITIES:

- Operational management for two of the Local Authority's Residential Homes for children and young people looked after and in crisis and resources to include staff, budgets and accommodation following agreed policies and procedures.
- Managing staff and undertaking supervision and appraisals in accordance with policy. Managing poor performance within the Human Resources policy and procedural framework.

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- Contributing to strategic/management meetings and effective multi-disciplinary and multi-agency working including the development of the service for which they are responsible.
- Making decisions and judgements about risk to staff and young people within the agreed management framework.
- Ensuring that assessments and plans are of satisfactory quality and are completed in line with local and national guidance.
- Ensuring that the service is delivered in line with requirements/standards contained in legislation, regulation, local and national guidance.
- Chairing meetings that facilitate effective multi-disciplinary and multi-agency working including the development of the service for which they are responsible.
- Ensuring the service is delivered in accordance with the requirements set out by The Regulation and Inspection of Social Care (Wales) Act 2016, take a lead role during any inspection undertaken by Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW) and make certain that quality assurance measures are in place and adhered to, taking action where any shortfalls are identified.
- Working as part of a multi-agency team to develop placement plans and risk assessments, along with direct work programmes to meet the individual needs of children and young people, achieving positive outcomes as identified through complex assessment.
- Working with the multi-disciplinary team to support young people to transition into adulthood and contribute to the development and delivery of the relevant Adult Social Care assessment and care planning processes.
- Working with the multi-disciplinary teams in Adult Services and contribute to the risk assessment processes, positive risk-taking plans and application of relevant legislation.
- Provide management cover and support across BCBC's other children's residential homes when this service is dormant.
- Assisting the Directorate Management team in the development of strategy, policy and procedures, including supporting the Group Manager and Responsible Individual – Children's Social Care, in the review and evaluation of the achievement of objectives, targets, priorities and standards.
- To be part of a voluntary on-call rota outside of normal working hours.
